Wild Salmon on Parade™ is inspired by the example and spirit of Soul Salmon (Olympia, 2001) and Cows on Parade (Chicago, 1999). Following Olympia's example, Wild Salmon on Parade has teamed up with organizations and artists to place large, wildly decorated fiberglass fish sculptures (not cows) in Anchorage.
